Does a "Download" button appear at the top?

Does a "Remove All" button appear at the top?

Are you still able to download the compiled data?

If so try using "Remove All" and refresh the page.

Also you could try compiling just one section to see how it goes.

Check all files in :
/administrator/components/com_export_content/zip/...

If after all the above and you are still getting the error message go to line 486 of
/administrator/components/com_export_content/admin.export_content.php where you will see this:

```

Try editing this out and let me know what happens:
